Dear Resident:

Enclosed please find a U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)/Nez Perce Tribe Small Burn Air Quality Permit form for 2018. The Small Burn permit application is for burns 10 feet or less in diameter or 60 feet or less of ditch bank or fence line vegetation. Larger burns require a different permit application be submitted. If you wish to burn small burns in 2018, please fill out Part "A" of the permit and return it to the Nez Perce Tribe ERWM Air Quality Program. Retain Part "B" of the permit and keep it available when burning.

Always follow the six-step burn permit process listed on your permit and keep a log of the dates you burn, location, quantity, type of materials burned and your fire safety precautions. Only burn allowable materials. Burning conducted without permission of the Nez Perce Tribe ERWM Air Quality Program, failure to follow permit procedures, and/or burning prohibited items are violations of the Federal Air Rules for Reservations (FARR) and the federal Clean Air Act and are subject to penalties up to \$44,539 per day of violation.
