Updates:

8. Fire/EMS – Chief Billing Monahan

Chief stated for the month of April there were 48 EMS calls with 4 IFT's and 5 Fire calls. Down 2 summer crew members, gained 3 new volunteers. The EMT class is going well with 3 EMTs ready to advance forward. Chief stressed how important is to pick up dead limbs and dead needles to keep down the risk of fire ignition. Keeping dead limbs cut on trees is important to stop fire from traveling at a higher speed. All fire hydrants have been flushed in the city and asking residents to weed Wack around the hydrants. Chief also mentioned the Fire Tax has no updated since 1974.

9. Pool Update – Mike Tornatore

Mike talked about the funding of the Kamiah pool with a locked account at FNCU of 439,454.90. Mike talked about the prior contractor and the mess they created in not having much knowledge of how to fix the pool therefore, wasting a lot of city funds to the contractor for a job they did not fix as needed for the pool. Mike mentioned he is working with potential partners for pool work and the need to raise a lot of money to get the pool

fixed. Mike mentioned it will cost over a million dollars to repair the pool. The partners he has been talking to will guarantee a 25 year warranty on the work.

10. Park – Water Update - Mayor

Mayor talked about the need to water the park and the issues of not being able to produce enough water to water the park. Mayor mentioned they have reached out to USDA Rural Development to assist with a water rate study. It was also noted the WTP was built in 2015 and two water filters are going bad. Insert attached.
