**A. Lewis County Sheriff – Jason Davis**

**B. Fire/EMS – Chief Billy Monahan**

Chief talked about the Life Pack Grant and the upcoming match that will need to be paid by end of Sept of 2025 in the amount of \$14,000. Vince Missman repaired Engine 21 & 22.

**C. Wastewater Plant – Jim Lund**

Jim talked about finding a better solution to the sludge drop box and advises the city to consider hauling the sludge to Lewiston which would cost close to \$15,000 a year for transport. In the long haul Orofino is dumping 80% of their sludge at the WWTP and that volume has increased from \$650 a month to \$980. Jim mentioned the dump truck door is being fixed with a new door to be sure the seal is fixed.

**D. Reviewing Utility Hook-up Fees/Changes – Jim Lund-Stu Bryant**

Jim advised moving in a direction for the better of the city and revenues by raising water hook-up fees by the customer paying for their own hook-up not the city paying.
